If you will be entering the 7th, 8th or 9th grade next fall, we invite you to become a **Junior Volunteer** or **CIT**. Experience the fun of meeting new friends your own age, learning new skills, and helping others in a fun-filled environment that's just for kids! **A limited number of openings are available. You must be responsible, like people, have a good sense of humor, and be willing to learn new things!**

cit's work closely with experienced teachers at the Museum's Mini Camps and learn responsibility by:

- providing friendly faces to help our campers transition into camp activities
- guiding campers in creative camp crafts
- developing important organizational, time management, and leadership skills

The cost is \$50 per 2 week session, and includes t-shirt, training, daily snacks and the possibility to apply for a future paid staff position here and at other camps. Participants can qualify for community service hours. CIT hours are 8:30am-12:30pm, 3-days a week, and participants must enroll for 2 week blocks based on the Museum camp schedule. *If you are interested in becoming a CIT you must attend the training session on **Wednesday, June 10** or **Thursday, June 11** from 4-5:30 pm.*
