With three floors of themed, interactive exhibits, and *The Wild Place*, an outdoor learning center, the Museum is the ideal location for group visits by children ages 1 - 8 years old.

about your visit

After a brief orientation by Museum staff, your group will be divided into several small groups. Discovery Cards will assist your teaching staff and chaperones as they guide their groups through the exhibit areas.

These age and grade appropriate Discovery Cards offer suggestions for group and individual activities which are thought-provoking, and fun-filled opportunities for learning. The activities are based upon the Massachusetts Curriculum Frameworks.
