The Quad-City Labyrinth Project will join the Martin Luther King Center in presenting the “Keep the Dream Alive Labyrinth Walk” from 6-9 p.m. March 23 in the Rev. Grimes Community Room at the Martin Luther King Center in Rock Island.

Introductions will be provided for first-time walkers, so participants can begin their walk anytime between 6 and 8 p.m. The process takes about an hour, including a brief introduction to the labyrinth, the walk itself and some time for reflection afterward.

The purpose of the walk is to honor the life of Coretta Scott King and the King legacy by walking in the footsteps of the two great leaders. Because the labyrinth consists of a single path, it is a perfect metaphor for the path of life that unites us all as human beings.

This event is offered as a function of the Global Healing Response Network, which provides public access to labyrinths in response to local tragedies, national disasters and global catastrophes, including the loss of world leaders.
