Ceramics both functional and sculptural

This CLAY STUDIO, taught by ROBYN ZELLAR, is an open studio for individuals to explore their creativity through clay. Each student will have the opportunity to plan and create original works while improving their hand building skills. Students will be free to create both functional and sculptural objects.

Students will learn basic ceramic techniques that include coil, slab, pinch and add. Robyn will help each student take his or her idea from a lump of clay to a fired and glazed work of art.

Our teacher, Robyn Zellar, is the art teacher at the Baldwin School. She has sixteen years of elementary teaching experience, eight of which she spent teaching art at international schools in China. Robyn curated a show this winter in the Sacramento Street Gallery
