ABOUT THIS CLASS

Drawing: Character Studies/Comic Books

This drawing class, taught by RAUL GONZALEZ, will focus on character design, beginning with the face and its expressions, then the body, and finally the character's environment. Students will learn about pacing, movement and gestural line drawing. Students will learn how to use the Brush, Pen, and Dip Pen employing cross hatching, brushing and wash techniques. Finally students will map out, then pencil and ink pages for comic books.

While the format is comic books, the focus is on character development, and all kinds of characters will be developed (not only superheroes!)

This class will continue work begun in September for students who are continuing. New students will have time to begin the process of creating a character.

ABOUT OUR TEACHER



Our teacher, Raul Gonzalez, is a professional artist who studied at the University of Texas. He designed the posters, banners and T-shirts for ArtBeat 2007 in Somerville. Gonzalez's work has been exhibited in many galleries including the Rhys Gallery, Bernard Toale Gallery, Tufts Aidekman Art Center and Brookline

Arts Center. He has taught at the Museum of Fine Arts and the Brookline Arts Center. He was the art specialist at OUTBACK in summer 2008 and recently illustrated the book, *Philosophical Tales*, by Martin Cohen and published by Blackwell publishing.
