Perhaps it is hard to believe, but 2008 marks the 25th Silver Anniversary of the establishment of the Cape Cod Community College Educational Foundation! We applaud friends like you for helping us to realize this significant milestone.

The Foundation has played a role in almost every new College initiative since our founding in 1983. Thanks to our generous supporters, we have been able to provide seed money for so many dynamic projects, programs, enhancement grants, student and faculty scholarships, and building improvements over our 25-year-history.

When the College Foundation was incorporated, it was uncommon for a private foundation to raise funds for a public institution. Initially, the Foundation set some small, attainable goals to establish scholarships and raise money to purchase equipment. This year alone, the Foundation will award nearly \$400,000 in scholarship aid and embark on a \$1 million campaign to renovate and expand the William Brewster Nickerson Cape Cod History Archives at the Wilkens Library.
