FOURTH ANNUAL UNITED WAY DAY OF CARING TOUCHES 274 LIVES

Two hundred seventy-four lives were touched on Monday, September 11, 2006 during the 4th Annual United Way Day of Caring. Sixty-three projects were submitted for this year's day of caring and fifty-three of those projects have been completed. United Way will continue to work in the coming months to recruit volunteers to complete the outstanding 9 projects. Of the 63 projects, 24 included building and repair, five required painting, six involved cleaning, 9 focused on gardening and landscaping and 22 projects were categorized as human service projects such as organizing and conducting activities to be completed by Big Brothers Big Sisters waiting list children or the residents of the group homes, visiting shut-ins, and supply drives.

"One hundred sixty-eight volunteers from companies and organizations throughout Davie County provided the power to make this program successful," stated Day of Caring Chair, Regina Graham. "We couldn't have done it without them!" United Way would
