Annual C. Mills Reeves Student Essay Contest

A contest open to students currently enrolled in a college or Graduate degree program in preparation for a career in one of the many public health disciplines.

First Prize: \$200 plus expenses to conference (not to exceed \$400)

Honorable Mention: \$100

Deadline: January 15, 2010

Rules:

Essays must address the 2010 Conference Theme “Cresting the Wave: 2010 and Beyond” or a current public health issue.

Essay must be a minimum of 500 words and a maximum of 1500 words and the original work of the student.

Essays must be in MS Word, double-spaced with twelve-point font. Pages should be numbered.

Entries may be submitted to the Association electronically.

Name, full address, and telephone number with a short, one paragraph autobiographical summary of the author must be submitted on a cover page.

Essays must include a bibliography.

Essays will be judged on knowledge of subject matter, utilization of literature and research, originality of ideas, development of point of view, insight, clarity of expression, organization and grammar.

Publication:

All essays submitted become the property of the Texas Public Health Association.

Notification of Winners:

Winners will be notified by March 15th with winning essays featured and prizes awarded at the Texas Public Health Association’s Annual Educational Conference in South Padre Island, Texas, April 21-23, 2010
